History

Since 1902, the Humane Society of Greater Dayton has helped animals in need within our community. We have 15 offsite adoption locations, including the MeowZa Cat Boutique. Our primary adoption center houses 20-35 dogs, 70-90 cats and 7-10 rabbits and many other types of animals, too.

What We Do

- Find homes for homeless pets
- Lower pet overpopulation through our spay/neuter programs
- Reunite lost pets with families
- Work to eliminate abuse and neglect through cruelty investigations
- Serve as a resource for pet owners to improve the human-animal bond
- Collaborate with community groups and companies to make our programs more effective

2014 By the Numbers

- **2,188** Animals found or were placed into loving, forever homes.
- **2,077** Cats have found forever homes through the MeowZa Cat Boutique since opening its doors in 2008. This year alone, 379 lucky cats found new homes.
- **15** Offsite adoption centers helped us find homes for thousands of cats.
- **3,891** Spay/Neuter surgeries were performed at our facilities this year, helping combat overpopulation.
- **484** People volunteered, logging 73,495.27 hours of service. That's equal to 35 full-time employees!
- **2,034** Animals went through our foster program before being placed up for adoption.
- **529** Cases of cruelty or neglect were investigated by our humane agent, which resulted in 58 warnings issued, 395 animals removed and 49 injured animals rescued.
- **133** Events were held in the community to raise awareness on animal issues and care.

Budget & Financials

- The Humane Society is a 501(c)(3) organization and relies solely on donations and grants to meet our \$1.7 million annual budget.
- Spent \$2,104 per day on direct animal care
- Annual costs of utilities and facility maintenance at animal care center is \$100,008.
