## History

Since 1902, the Humane Society of Greater Dayton has helped animals in need within our community. Through the years, we have grown to become the area's largest no-kill animal welfare agency. We have 21 offsite adoption locations, including the MeowZa Cat Boutique. Our primary adoption center houses 20-35 dogs, 70-90 cats and 7-10 rabbits and other types of animals, too.

## 2015 By the Numbers

- 1,853 Animals found or were placed into loving, forever homes
- 2,770 Cats have found forever homes through the MeowZa Cat Boutique since opening it's doors in 2008. This year alone 314 lucky cats found new homes.
- 21 Offsite adoption centers helped us find homes for thousands of cats.
- 3,581 Spay/Neuter surgeries were performed at our facilities this year, helping combat overpopulation.
- 70,619 hours were logged by our generous volunteers. That's equal to nearly 34 full-time employees!
- 203 Cases of cruelty or neglect were investigated by our humane agent, which resulted in 36 warnings issued, 155 animals removed and 46 injured animals rescued.

## Budget & Financials

- The Humane Society of Greater Dayton is a 501(c)(3) organization and relies solely on donations and grants to meet our \$1.8 million annual budget.
- Spent \$2,038 per day on direct animal care
- Annual costs of utilities and facility maintenance at animal care center is \$103,406.
